Breakthrough Science Society, All India Save Education Committee, All India Secular Forum and Child Rights Protection Forum jointly organised an Educational Convention on “NEW EDUCATION POLICY-2015 & REWRITTING OF SCIENCE AND HISTORY” at Hyderabad on Nov 10, 2015.

Prof P L Vishweswar Rao (President AISEC, Telangana) presided. Sri.Babu Gogineni (Renowned Rationalist), Sri S Govindarajulu (Secretary, AISEC), Sri.Md.Zaheeruddin (Managing Editor, Siasat Urdu daily), Sri.G.Sudhakar Goud (Former Director, British library), Dr G Nagarjuna (Former HOD, Printing Technology) and Mr.R.Gangadhar (Convener, BSS) participated as speakers.

Prof P LV Rao in his speech expressed his deep concern about the growing intolerance in the country. He praised the scientists, writers, poets, film makers who returned their awards protesting the Govt’s attitude towards intolerance being spread in the society.

Sri S Govindarajulu (Secretary, AISEC) spoke about the communalisation of education. He pointed out the inclusion of unscientific ideas, views and thoughts into education by Government’s so called New Education policy. Quoting from Vivekananda, Raja Rammohan Roy, Vidyasagar and others he stressed the need for scientific education.

Sri Babu Gogineni (Renowned Rationalist) elaborately explained the history of science and the renaissance movement in Europe. In his speech he pointed out the detrimental role played by caste system and religious fundamentalism in the development of society.

At the end of the session, Mr.Soban proposed a resolution ‘Against communalisation of education and in praise of eminent personalities who returned their awards’. The house unanimously passed the resolution.

The convention concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr.P.Teja (Member, AISEC)

Nearly 200 delegates actively participated in the convention.
