Medical relief work in flood affected areas of Tamilnadu

The recent devastating rain and flood in Tamilnadu caused untold suffering, trauma and loss of property and household belongings to lakhs of people. Breakthrough Science Society took active part in organizing relief works in the flood affected areas and assisted the Medical Service Centre, a voluntary organization of doctors in setting up medical camps in Chennai and Cuddalore.

Medical camps were set up in the following places:

13 Dec to 14 Dec, 2015 - 2 camps in Alampadi, Cuddalore 15 Dec to 19 Dec, 2015 - 7 camps in Vysarpadi, Chennai 18 Dec and 20 Dec, 2015 - 2 camps in Korukkupet, Chennai 21 Dec, 2015 - 1 camp in Otteri, Chennai

22 Dec, 2015 - 1 camp in West Mambalam, Chennai

27 - 28 Dec, 2015 - 2 camps in Rayalanagar, Ramapuram, Chennai

Nearly 5000 people availed medical help from these camps. Doctor teams of MSC mainly from Karnataka and Kerala served in the camps. Nurses and pharmacists from Villupuram and Chennai served in the camps. Volunteers from the localities as well as students from different colleges actively assisted in conducting the camps. People from all over India and also from abroad generously contributed towards organising the camps and the purchase of medicines. The local people enthusiastically helped in setting up the camps by providing halls, materials and food and shelter for the doctors, nurses and volunteers.
